#### **School Hall**

The prospective contractors for the new hall construction are meeting on site next Tuesday! Very exciting!

#### Last month, I mentioned that we had a Police Incident outside the Senior Campus.

The students involved have been removed from the College community.

  order of learning. Instead of presenting information, or 'the answer', up-front, teachers start with a range of scenarios,
  questions and problems for students to navigate; something that happens in the high-capacity classes. A few teachers on
  the Junior Campus have been watching high capacity and wanting to replicate it in their classes.

#### Wellbeing

- Staffing seems to be easing
- Non-teaching is difficult at the moment, I don't think we've have a full Admin Officer team in months. Louise hasn't sat outside my office for more than two days this term.

#### Inclusion

• We started our conversations last week around the new funding model for students that require adjustments. The funding model now covers students that need ongoing adjustments (not just the verified disabilities that the department used to recognise). It is a big win for students with mental health, ADHD, dyslexia for example. Some students currently entitled to funding may not be eligible under the new model, but the students that we have forecasted are currently high functioning and work well with the basic differentiation of the classroom teacher anyway. It will roll out throughout 2023 and 2024.




